§ 60-8. Newly acquired dog and dog attaining licensing age.

The owner of any newly acquired dog of licensing age or of any dog which attains licensing age shall make application for license and registration tag for such dog within 10 days after such acquisition or age attainment. The fee shall be the same as required in § 60-4. Failure to obtain a license as provided herein shall result in a delinquent fee being imposed as set forth in § 60-6. The owner shall be required to present sufficient proof to establish that the dog was acquired after February 1 and that application has been submitted within the ten-day requirement.

STATE REGULATIONS:

1. The duration of immunity as reflected on the rabies certificate should extend throughout the period for which a license is being issued; however, dogs with a duration of immunity that expires before the end of the license period are considered acceptable for licensing, provided the expiration date is no more than two months prior to the end of the license period. Dogs with a duration of immunity for rabies which expires more than two months prior to the end of the licensure period should be boosted prior to the issuance of a license.
